1 AN ACT relating to public schools; eliminating required
2 high school diploma endorsements specifying different types
3 of student proficiency; modifying graduation requirements;
4 and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iv)(intro) is amended to
9 read:

11 **21-2-304. Duties of the state board of education.**

12

13 (a) The state board of education shall:

14

15 (iv) Establish, in consultation with local school
16 districts, requirements for students to earn a high school
17 diploma as measured by each district's body of evidence

1 assessment system ~~prescribed by rule and regulation of the~~
2 ~~state board and~~ required under W.S. ~~21-3-110(a)(xxii)~~. A
3 ~~high school diploma shall provide for one (1) of the~~
4 ~~following endorsements which shall be stated on the~~
5 ~~transcript of each student:~~ 21-3-110(a)(xxiv) in not less
6 than five (5) of the nine (9) content areas as determined
7 by the board of trustees of the respective school district.
8 Commencing with requirements for students graduating in
9 school year 2007-2008, two (2) of the five (5) content
10 areas shall include language arts and math;

12 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iv)(A) through (C) and
13 21-3-110(a)(xxv) are repealed.

14

15 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
