Public transit account-appropriation.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the public transit account; providing an  
2 appropriation; specifying uses for the appropriation;  
3 providing for distribution of funds; requiring rules and  
4 regulations; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.**

9

10 (a) There is appropriated one million dollars  
11 (\$1,000,000.00) from the general fund to the department of  
12 transportation. The funds appropriated under this act  
13 shall be deposited in a separate account within the public  
14 transit account created by W.S. 24-15-102.

15

16 (b) The funds and any interest earned under the  
17 separate account within the public transit account shall be

1 distributed to eligible grantees under the public transit  
2 program created by W.S. 24-15-101, pursuant to rules  
3 promulgated by the department of transportation. The  
4 department of transportation shall promulgate rules and  
5 regulations that specify the funds within the separate  
6 account shall be used only for operational expenses and  
7 shall not be used for capital improvements. To the extent  
8 funds, including interest earned on the funds, are  
9 available, the department of transportation may distribute  
10 funds from the separate account within the public transit  
11 account to eligible grantees as follows:

12

13 (i) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,  
14 not more than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) may be  
15 distributed.

16

17 (c) The funds distributed by the department of  
18 transportation from the separate account within the public  
19 transit account shall be in addition to any funds  
20 distributed under W.S. 24-15-102.

21

22 **Section 2.** The appropriation under this act shall be  
23 considered a one-time appropriation, and shall not be  
24 considered a part of the division's standard budget during

1 the department of administration and information's budget  
2 preparation cycle in the 2007-2008 biennium budget.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
