6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 6-9-203 is created to read:

10	6-9-203. Unlawful use of toxic substances; penalty.

12	(a) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of a
13	toxic substance if he inhales or ingests or possesses with
14	the purpose to inhale or ingest, for the purpose of
15	altering his mental or physical state, any toxic substance

1 that is not manufactured for human consumption or 2 inhalation. 3 4 (b) As used in this section "toxic substance" means: 5 (i) Volatile solvents including, but not limited 6 to, paint thinner, gasoline, correction fluid, felt-tip 7 markers, nail polish remover and glue; 8 9 (ii) Aerosols containing propellants 10 and 11 solvents such as toluene including, but not limited to, 12 spray paint, deodorant, hair products, cooking products and 13 fabric protectors; 14 15 (iii) Gases including, but not limited to, 16 butane, refrigerants and organic hydrocarbons not created 17 for human ingestion, inhalation or injection; and 18 19 (iv) Nitrates including, but not limited to 20 cyclohexyl nitrate, amyl nitrate and butyl nitrate. 21 22 (c) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section do not apply to a bona fide institution of higher education 23 24 conducting research with human volunteers pursuant to 2

1	guidelines adopted by the institution or any federal	or
2	state agency.

4	(d) A violation of this section is punishable	by
5	imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine	of
6	not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00),	or
