Section 2. There is appropriated from the general fund one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), or as much thereof as may be necessary, to the veterans' commission to carry out the purposes of this act.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
