may censure the licensee, place the licensee on probation 4

payment of fees; effect of failure to renew; inactive 10

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13 (a) Licenses issued under this act may be renewed for

successive three (3) year periods. Application for renewal 14

of any license issued prior to this act shall be made 15

before December 31, 1983. Thereafter the application shall 16

17 be made before December 31 of the third year of the license

The commission may establish a grace period for 18 period.

19 license renewal not to exceed sixty (60) days. The

20 commission may establish a late fee for license renewal not

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21 to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
