The lien shall not exceed the cost of the 7 reclamation work or be the amount determined by the 8 9 appraisal to be the increase in the fair market value of 10 the land as a result of the restoration, reclamation, 11 abatement, control or prevention of the adverse effects of 12 past coal or mineral mining practices., whichever is less. 13 No lien shall be filed under this section against the 14 property of any person who owned the surface prior to May 2, 1977, and who neither consented to, participated in, nor 15 16 exercised control over the mining operation which 17 necessitated the reclamation project.

19 The landowner may petition the district court for (b) 20 the district in which the majority of the land is located 21 within sixty (60) days of the filing of the lien to 22 determine the increase in the fair market value of the 23 land. The amount reported to be the increase in value of 24 the premises, but not exceeding the cost of the reclamation
