A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; imposing conditions upon
2 school district equipment purchases reimbursed under the
3 special education adjustment to the cost-based school
4 finance funding formula; modifying required district
5 reporting accordingly; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-321 by creating a new
10 subsection (g) is amended to read:

11

12 **21-13-321. Special education; adjustment to**
13 **foundation program formula.**

15 (g) Assistive technology equipment included within
16 district expenditures for special education programs and

1 services and reported under paragraph (b)(ii) of this
2 section, which was acquired to assist a student with a
3 specific disability, shall to the extent practicable,
4 transfer with that student if the student transfers to
5 another school district within the state. Within the report
6 required under subsection (d) of this section, districts
7 shall separately document assistive technology equipment
8 and shall report to the department equipment which is
9 accordingly transferred to another school district. This
10 subsection applies only if no other student within the
11 district currently uses the equipment and the equipment is
12 capable of transfer to another district.

13

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
