W.S. 36-4-121(h) is amended to read: 10 11 36-4-121. Permits to use state parks, recreation 12 areas and historic sites. 13 14 The funds received by the department from the (h) 15 sale of the permits shall be deposited in a capital 16 construction account within the enterprise fund and may be

1 expended by the <u>division department</u> for capital 2 construction projects, <u>major maintenance</u>, and site 3 interpretation such as exhibits, signage and displays as 4 approved by the legislature.

6 Section 2. There is appropriated eleven million 7 dollars (\$11,000,000.00) from the general fund to the department of state parks and cultural resources, to fund 8 9 road construction and major maintenance needs at outdoor recreation areas and facilities as defined in W.S. 10 11 36-4-103. The department shall prepare a five-year plan 12 addressing capital needs, budget and need for general 13 funds, if any. The department shall submit its plan and a report to the joint appropriations and joint travel, 14 recreation and wildlife interim committees by December 30, 15 16 2005.

18 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 21 Constitution.
