State-tribal liaison.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government;
2 authorizing two positions for the state-tribal liaison
3 program; providing an appropriation; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.**

9

10 (a) The governor is authorized two (2) full-time
11 positions for the state-tribal liaison and staff for the
12 purpose of implementing W.S. 9-1-221 and this act. There
13 is appropriated from the general fund to the office of the
14 governor, not to exceed one hundred twenty thousand dollars
15 (\$120,000.00) for the purpose of funding the salary and
16 administrative expenses for the state-tribal liaison
17 program for the period beginning with the effective date of

1 this act and ending June 30, 2006. A request to continue
2 funding these two (2) tribal liaison positions will be
3 included in the governor's 2007-2008 biennium standard
4 budget request.

5

6 (b) In addition to the duties described in W.S.
7 9-1-221, the tribal liaison shall consult with the governor
8 and the select committee on tribal relations in developing
9 an immediate action plan and a long-term state-tribal
10 policy.

11

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
15 Constitution.
