appropriations interim committees not later than October 1, 1 2 2005. 3 4 (b) The study shall at a minimum include: 5 (i) Current Medicaid reimbursement rates for 6 7 care of Alzheimer's disease patients and patients with other dementias as they compare to average long term care 8 9 costs; 10 (ii) Projected need over ten (10) years for beds 11 in long term care facilities in the state to care for 12 13 Alzheimer's disease patients; and 14 15 (iii) Recommendations regarding the Medicaid reimbursement rate for care of Alzheimer's disease patients 16 in this state. 17

19 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 20 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 21 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Constitution. 22
