Amounts distributed under subsection (b) of this 1 (e) 2 section shall be deposited by the recipient district into a 3 separate account, the balance of which may accumulate from 4 year-to-year. Except as specified under subsection (f) of 5 this section, expenditures from the separate account, including any interest earnings on the account, shall be 6 7 restricted to expenses incurred for major building and facility repair and replacement as defined in subsection 8 9 (a) of this section and as prescribed by rule and regulation of the commission, and shall be in accordance 10 11 the district's facility plan approved by the with 12 commission under W.S. 21-15-116. The district's facility 13 plan shall clearly specify proposed major maintenance expenditures for addressing district major building and 14 facility repair and replacement needs over the next five 15 16 (5) years on a building-by-building basis, updated annually 17 for the applicable reporting period, which shall be aligned to the statewide adequacy standards and prioritized based 18 upon the impact of the building or facility on the 19 20 district's ability to deliver the required educational 21 program. The district shall include plans for maintaining 22 any district building or facility which is under a lease agreement, specifying lease revenues available to the 23 24 district for maintenance of facilities to the level

1 required by statewide adequacy standards. No expenditures 2 shall be made from the separate account unless the repair 3 or replacement of the building or facility systems for 4 which the expenditure is to be made is clearly specified 5 within the district's facility plan or otherwise approved by the commission. In a manner and form required by 6 7 commission rule and regulation, each district shall annually report to the commission on the expenditures made 8 9 from the separate account during the applicable reporting 10 period, separating account expenditures on a building-bybuilding basis. The commission shall annually review 11 12 account expenditures and shall report expenditures to the 13 select committee on school facilities established under 14 W.S. 28-11-301. The commission shall compile reported building-by-building expenditure information for each 15 district and the district five (5) year plan and include 16 17 this information in its annual report to the select committee pursuant to W.S. 21-15-121. 18

20 (f) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, a
21 district may expend up to ten percent (10%) of the amount
22 distributed during any school year under subsection (b) of
23 this section for major building and facility repair and
24 replacement needs of the district which are not specified

1	in the district's facility plan, including expenditures for
2	maintenance of district enhancements. Expenditures shall
3	be made under this subsection only after the district's
4	building and facility repair and replacement needs
5	specified in its facility plan have been addressed in
6	accordance with subsection (e) of this section and the
7	commission has approved the district's proposed
8	expenditures under this subsection. Each district shall
9	include expenditures under this subsection within the
10	annual report required under subsection (e) of this
11	section. Nothing in this subsection shall prohibit or
12	limit the application of subparagraph (c)(i)(D) of this
13	section in computing a district's building and facility
14	gross square footage for purposes of determining payment
15	amounts under this section. If any school district exceeds
16	expenditure limitations prescribed by this subsection or
17	fails to comply with expenditure levels for facility
18	adequacy needs identified within its facility plan, the
19	payments for that district in the immediately succeeding
20	year shall be reduced by the excess expenditure amount.

22	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
