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- 11 (c) The department shall certify to the state
- 12 treasurer amounts to be credited to appropriate accounts
- 13 based upon deductions from the taxes collected under this
- 14 article in the following order:

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1	(ii) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in
2	snowmobiles, computed by multiplying the number of
3	snowmobiles for which registration and user fees have been
4	paid during the current fiscal year under W.S.
5	31-2-404(a)(i) and 31-2-409(a)(ii) times sixteen dollars
6	and twenty-five cents (\$16.25) twenty-six dollars (\$26.00)
7	plus the number of gallons of gasoline used by snowmobiles
8	for which registration fees have been paid during the
9	current fiscal year under W.S. 31-2-404(a)(ii) times
10	thirty-two dollars and fifty cents (\$32.50) the current
11	gasoline tax rate as defined by W.S. 39-17-104(a)(i). The
12	number of gallons used by commercial snowmobiles shall be
13	reported to the department by all businesses offering
14	commercial snowmobile recreational leasing. The amount
15	amounts computed shall be credited to an account within the
16	earmarked revenue fund to be expended by the department of
17	state parks and cultural resources to improve snowmobile
18	trails in Wyoming;
