Section 1. W.S. 9-3-402(a) (xviii) is amended to read:

15 (a) As used in this article:

(xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" 1 2 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county police officer, duly authorized 3 sheriff, municipal 4 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the 5 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), investigator employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 6 7 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, probation 8 9 and parole agent employed by the Wyoming department of corrections, Wyoming law enforcement academy instructor, 10 University of Wyoming campus police officer, detention 11 12 officer or dispatcher for law enforcement agencies;

(a) Coverage of probation and parole agents employed 16 by the Wyoming department of corrections under W.S. 9-3-432 17 as provided by section 1 of this act shall not be 18 implemented by the Wyoming retirement board until funds 19 20 payable to the Wyoming retirement system are received for 21 deposit into the retirement account, as necessary for 22 maintaining the actuarial integrity of the account and funding all liability arising under this act, for years of 23

1 service prior to the date of entry or expansion of

2 coverage.

4 (b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section, 5 W.S. 9-3-432, with respect to probation and parole agents employed by the Wyoming department of corrections shall not 6 7 be implemented by the Wyoming retirement board until funds necessary for maintaining the actuarial integrity of the 8 9 account and funding any liability arising under this act, are deposited into the Wyoming retirement account by the 10 of corrections and contributions 11 Wyomina department 12 required under W.S. 9-3-432(a) and (b) are paid to the 13 Wyoming retirement system for deposit into the retirement

account for at least two (2) months of covered service

following the date of entry of coverage, as applicable.

17 Section 3. There is appropriated two million four ninety-six thousand three hundred twenty-one 18 hundred 19 (\$2,496,321.00) from the general fund to the dollars 20 department of corrections to be deposited in the retirement 21 account as required by section 2 of this act to fund the 22 liability arising under this act for the coverage of Wyoming probation and parole agents employed by the 23
