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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-15-114(a) by creating a new
- 8 paragraph (xiv) and by renumbering (xiv) as (xv) and
- 9 21-15-116(a)(intro) are amended to read:

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- 11 21-15-114. Powers and duties; school facilities
- 12 office created; director.

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14 (a) The school facilities commission shall:

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Τ	(xiv) Review any proposed sale of existing land
2	owned by a district, which land is within the scope of the
3	district's five (5) year facility plan, and the impact of
4	the land disposition upon that plan. The commission may
5	disapprove any plans submitted pursuant to this paragraph
6	to protect the financial interests of the state if the
7	plans are not otherwise in the public interest. If the
8	commission determines land disposition adversely impacts
9	the cost-effectiveness of the district's five (5) year
10	plan, the revenues resulting from land disposition shall be
11	considered by the commission in any future building or
12	facility remedy for that district and notwithstanding
13	paragraph (x) of this subsection, may at the direction of
14	the commission to the department of education, be
15	considered or counted under W.S. 21-13-310(a)(xiv) or (xv);

18	select committee on school facilities, promulgate necessary
19	rules and regulations to administer and implement this act.

21	21-15-116. School district facility plans; filing
22	with commission; commission review; judicial review.

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(a) Each school district shall, in accordance with 1 2 rules and regulations of the commission, and with the 3 assistance of professional facility planning expertise and 4 a representative of the commission, develop long range 5 comprehensive school building and facility plans for the district which address district wide building and facility 6 needs over a five (5) year period. The plan shall be in a 7 form and format specified by rule and regulation of the 8 9 commission and shall identify building and facility needs 10 in accordance with the statewide adequacy standards, 11 actions to remediate building and facility inadequacies 12 including construction, renovation and major building and 13 facility repair and replacement expenditures, and any local enhancements to buildings and facilities beyond statewide 14 adequacy standards. The plans shall include a response to 15 each building and facility inadequacy identified by the 16 17 needs assessment on a building-by-building, space-by-space basis. The plan shall also review and to the extent 18 practical, identify nonconstruction alternatives 19 to 20 building and facility inadequacies such as 21 closure, modification of school boundaries, modification of 22 school grade configurations and similar approaches. Demolition or use, lease or other methods of disposition of 23 24 commission determined surplus buildings and facilities

shall be incorporated as part of the district plan, 1

2 including the disposition of any existing land owned by the

3 district. The plan shall also specify identified

4 alternative methods of building disposition, proposed

5 allocation of costs incurred or revenues resulting from

disposition and allocation of disposition revenues to 6

7 offset any costs paid by the commission. In addition,
