- 10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 11 Constitution, Article 6, Section 20 is proposed for
- 12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 13 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 14 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a

15 majority of the electors at the election:

1 Article 6, Section 20. Oath of office; form.

3 Senators and representatives and all judicial, state and county officers shall, before entering on the duties of 4 their respective offices, take and subscribe the following 5 oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that 6 7 I will support, obey and defend the constitution of the 8 United States, and the constitution of this state Wyoming, 9 and that I will discharge the duties of my office with 10 fidelity; that I have not paid or contributed, or promised 11 to pay or contribute, either directly or indirectly, any money or other valuable thing, to procure my nomination or 12 13 election, (or appointment) except for necessary and proper 14 expenses expressly authorized by law; that I have not, knowingly, violated any election law of the state related 15 16 to my election or appointment, or procured it to be done by others in my behalf."; that I will not knowingly receive, 17 18 directly or indirectly, any money or other valuable thing for the performance or nonperformance of any act or duty 19 pertaining to my office, other than the compensation 20 allowed by law." 21
