A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; providing
 2 certain requirements for physician licensure as specified;
 3 and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-26-303(a)(iv) is amended to read:

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9 **33-26-303. Requirements for granting license.**

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11 (a) The board may grant a license to practice
 12 medicine in this state to any applicant who demonstrates,
 13 to the satisfaction of a majority of the board, that he:

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15 (iv) Has provided written evidence that he has
 16 completed at least one (1) year of postgraduate training in
 17 an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A. or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program. An

1 applicant who graduated from a medical school not
2 accredited by the L.C.M.E. or A.O.A. shall present written
3 evidence that he has completed at least two (2) years of
4 medical education at the medical school from which he
5 graduated and that he has completed at least ~~three (3)~~ two
6 (2) years of postgraduate training in an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A.
7 or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program;

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9 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
