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8	Section 1. W.S. 35-26-102(a)(intro), (i), (ii), (b)
9	and by creating a new subsection (c) and 35-26-103(b) and
10	(c) are amended to read:
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12	35-26-102. Use of automated external defibrillator.
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14	(a) In order to ensure public health and safety, any
15	person who acquires <mark>all persons who use</mark> an AED shall<mark>:</mark>
16	ensure that:
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1	(i) Expected defibrillator users receive <u>Obtain</u>
2	appropriate training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
3	and in the use of an AED by the American Heart Association,
4	American Red Cross or by another nationally recognized, or
5	Wyoming department of health recognized, course in CPR and
6	AED use and maintains currency through refresher training
7	every two (2) years; <u>and</u>
8	
9	(ii) <u>Ensure that t</u> he AED is maintained and
10	tested according to the manufacturer's guidelines $.;$
11	
12	(b) Any person who acquires <u>or entity</u> in possession
13	of an AED shall notify an agent of the emergency
14	communications center and the local ambulance service of
15	the existence, location and type of AED.
16	
17	(c) Any person who uses an AED shall notify an agent
18	of the emergency communications center and the local
19	ambulance service upon each use of the AED.

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(b) The Any prescribing physician who authorizes the 1 2 purchase of the AED, the any individual who provides 3 training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the use 4 of an AED, and the person responsible for the site where 5 the AED is located shall also be immune from civil 6 liability for any personal injury that results from any act 7 or omission of acts that do not amount to willful or wanton misconduct or gross negligence if that person complies with 8 9 the requirements of W.S. 35-26-102. 10 11 (c) Any clinical use of the AED shall be reported to 12 the a licensed physician at the clinic where the AED is 13 used. 14 15 Section 2. W.S. 35-26-102(a)(iii) is repealed. 16 17 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 18
