1 AN ACT relating to counties; increasing salary ranges of
2 certain county officers as specified; and providing for an
3 effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-107(a) is amended to read:

9 **18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;**
10 **additional compensation prohibited; exception as to**
11 **traveling and other expenses; compensation of county**
12 **commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,**
13 **stenographers and other assistants.**

15 (a) ~~From and after January 1, 1979,~~ County officers
16 shall be paid as follows:

(i) The county assessor, part-time county and prosecuting attorneys, part-time county attorneys, county clerk, clerk of district court, county sheriff and county treasurer in their respective counties shall receive ~~not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)~~ as annual salaries~~:-~~.

(A) From and after ~~January 1, 1983,~~ the ~~specified county officers shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00). Full-time county and prosecuting attorneys shall receive not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) and not more than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) as annual salaries. From and after January 1, 1995, the specified full-time county officers shall receive an annual salary not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00). Full-time county attorneys shall receive not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) nor more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) as annual salaries. Full-time county and prosecuting attorneys shall receive not less than thirty-~~

1 ~~five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) nor more than sixty~~
2 ~~thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) as annual salaries. From and~~

5 (iii) Salaries shall be paid in equal monthly
6 installments. The board of county commissioners of each
7 county shall meet not later than June 1, 1978, and on or
8 before the same date each four (4) years thereafter, for
9 the purpose of setting salaries, which shall not be changed
10 during the term of each official for whom a salary is
11 determined.

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
