14	(a) No person who owns, rents, leases, subleases or
15	has control of any residence or premises shall allow an
16	open house party to take place at the residence or premises
17	if any alcoholic liquor, malt beverage or drug prohibited

1	by law is possessed or consumed at the residence or
2	premises by any minor and the person knowingly permitted
3	the residence or premises to be used for that purpose.

5	(b) The provision of this section shall not apply to:
6	
7	(i) The furnishing or giving of any alcoholic
8	liquor or malt beverage by an adult to any person under the
9	age of twenty-one (21) years, if the recipient is the legal
10	ward, medical patient or member of the immediate family of
11	the adult furnishing or giving the alcoholic liquor or malt
12	beverage;
13	
14	(ii) The consumption, use or possession of a
15	drug by a minor pursuant to a lawful prescription issued to
16	the minor for the drug;
17	
18	(iii) Religious observance or prescribed medical

21	(iv) The possession by a minor of alcoholic
22	liquor, malt beverage or lawfully prescribed drugs
23	incidental to the lawful employment of the minor.
