6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-9-203 is created to read:

10 6-9-203. Unlawful use of toxic substances; penalty.

- 12 (a) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of a
- 13 toxic substance if he inhales or ingests or possesses with
- 14 the purpose to inhale or ingest, for the purpose of
- 15 altering his mental or physical state, any substance with
- 16 toxic effects that is not manufactured for human
- 17 consumption or inhalation, including but not limited to

1 glue, fingernail polish, paint and paint thinners,

2 petroleum products, aerosol propellants and chemical

3 solvents.

5 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section

6 do not apply to a bona fide institution of higher education

7 conducting research with human volunteers pursuant to

8 guidelines adopted by the institution or any federal or

9 state agency.

10

11 (c) A violation of this section is punishable by

12 imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of

13 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or

14 both.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
