15	This chapter is known and may be cited as the "Wyoming
16	Commonsense Consumption Act".

Definitions. 3 4 (a) As used in this act: 5 (i) "Livestock" means as defined in W.S. 6 7 11-39-101(a)(vi); 8 9 (ii) "Livestock producer" means any producer of 10 livestock; 11 12 (iii) "Long term consumption" means the 13 cumulative effect of the consumption of any qualified 14 product and not the effect of a single instance of consumption; 15 16 17 (iv) "Qualified product" means any food or drink as defined in section 201(f) of the Federal Food Drug and 18 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. § 321(f)), and specifically 19 20 includes meat and meat products from livestock; 21 (v) "Seller" means any person or entity lawfully 22 engaged in the business of marketing, distributing, 23 advertising or selling a qualified product; 24

1 2 (vi) "Trade association" means any association 3 or business organization that is not operated for profit, 4 if two (2) or more members are manufacturers, marketers, 5 distributors, livestock producers, advertisers or sellers of a qualified product; 6 7 (vii) "This act" means W.S. 11-46-101 through 8 9 11-46-103. 10 11-46-103. Limitation on liability for long term 11 12 consumption. 13 14 No manufacturer, seller, trade association, livestock producer or retailer of a qualified product is subject to 15 civil liability for injury or death in any case in which 16 17 liability is based on the individual's weight gain, obesity or a health condition related to weight gain or obesity, 18 and the weight gain, obesity or health condition results 19 20 from the individual's long term consumption of a qualified 21 product. 22

23 Section 2. This act applies to any action commenced 24 on or after the effective date of this act.

2 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 4 5 Constitution. 6
