1 Service Act, issued by any state, territory or possession 2 of the United States, the District of Columbia, the 3 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or by an official governmental 4 agency of Canada or Mexico, a green card issued by the 5 federal bureau of citizenship and immigration services, a tribal identification card issued by the governing body of 6 7 a Native American or Alaskan tribe, an identification card issued to a member of the armed forces, an internationally 8 9 accepted passport document with a discernible date of birth and photograph or an identification card issued by the 10 11 department of transportation is prima facie evidence of the 12 age and identity of a person. Proof that a licensee or his 13 employee or agent demanded, was shown and acted reasonable reliance upon the information contained in any 14 one (1) of the above documents as identification is a 15 defense to any criminal prosecution or action for the 16 17 suspension or revocation of a license.
