1	AN ACT relating to the Wyoming livestock board; providing
2	for confidentiality of information obtained for purposes of

7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9	Section 1. W.S. 11-18-117 is created to read:

14	(a) All records, data and information collected by
15	the state, recorded or otherwise, for the purposes of a
16	national livestock identification program shall be

1 confidential and are not public records for purposes of 2 W.S. 16-4-201 through 16-4-205. The records, data and 3 information shall be released only upon order of the 4 Wyoming livestock board to appropriate governmental 5 agencies for the purposes of a national livestock identification program. The board shall not release any 6 records, data or information to a federal agency until the 7 agency confirms in writing that it will maintain the 8 9 records, data and information as confidential and that they 10 are not subject to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 11 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. Upon release by the board of 12 any information to any other governmental entity, the board 13 shall notify the person to whom the information refers or pertains that the release has been made, the name of the 14 entity to whom the information was released and shall 15 provide a copy or summary of the information contained in 16 17 the release.

(b) A person who knowingly provides false information to the Wyoming livestock board for purposes of a national livestock identification program shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), imprisonment for up to six (6) months, or both.

2	(c) A person who refuses to provide to the livestock
3	board information that is required under federal law for
4	purposes of a national livestock identification program
5	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up
6	to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), imprisonment for up to
7	six (6) months, or both.

9	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
