- 6 providing for an effective date.

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-1402(e) is amended to read:

- 12 31-5-1402. Safety belts required to be used;
- 13 exceptions; reduction in fine.

- 15 (e) All citations for violations of the motor vehicle
- 16 laws of this state and for violations of traffic ordinances

or traffic regulations of a local authority shall contain a 1 2 notation by the issuing officer indicating whether the 3 driver and passengers complied with this section. 4 Compliance with this section shall entitle a licensee to a 5 ten dollar (\$10.00) reduction in the fine otherwise imposed by any court having jurisdiction over the alleged offense. 6 7 The driver who violates this section may be issued a citation and may be subject to a fine of not more than 8 9 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00). Any 10 passenger who violates this section may be issued a citation and may be subject to a fine of not more than $\frac{\mathsf{ten}}{\mathsf{ten}}$ 11 12 dollars (\$10.00) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). 13 14 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-5-1402(d) and (f) is repealed. 15

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
