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2 (B) Any county, except—county memorial 3 hospitals or hospital, special hospital districts district, 4 city or town or legally constituted department designated 5 to the board by the appropriate governing body as employer under this article; 6 7 8 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-3-402(a) (vii) (F) (III) is repealed. 9 Section 3. 10

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12 (a) Coverage of county hospital or special hospital district employees as authorized under section 1 of this 13 act shall not be implemented by the Wyoming retirement 14 board until funds payable to the Wyoming retirement system 15 are received for deposit into the retirement account, as 16 17 necessary for maintaining the actuarial integrity of the account and funding all liability arising under this act, 18 for years of service prior to the date of entry or 19 20 expansion of coverage.

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22 (b) Prior to January 1, 2006, any hospital employee shall elect to participate in either the retirement plan 23 offered by the employing institution or the 24

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retirement system. Each employee shall prior to January 1,
2 2006, provide written notice to the employing institution
and the Wyoming retirement board of his election under this
subsection. If an employee fails to notify the employing
institution which retirement plan he selects, the

6 institution shall notify the retirement board of this

7 omission and the retirement board shall serve notice on the

8 employee by registered mail return receipt requested that

9 participation in the Wyoming retirement system was not

10 selected. All retirement contributions made on and after

11 January 1, 2006, by any employee, together with matching

12 employer contributions on his behalf, shall be made to the

13 elected plan. An election pursuant to this subsection is

14 irrevocable during the remainder of an employee's working

15 career as an employee.
