7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-5-101(b) and 37-5-107(a)(i) are
- 10 amended to read:

12 37-5-101. Wyoming natural gas pipeline authority.

- 14 (b) The authority shall be governed by a board
- 15 composed of five (5) members appointed by the governor,
- 16 with the advice and consent of the senate. The members of

1 the initial board shall be appointed for staggered terms, 2 two (2) members for terms of one (1) year each and the 3 other members for terms of two (2), three (3) and four (4) 4 years, respectively, as designated at the time 5 appointment. Thereafter all members shall be appointed for four (4) year terms. The governor may remove any member as 6 7 provided in W.S. 9-1-202. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the governor in accordance with W.S. 8 9 28-12-101. The members shall elect from the membership a 10 chairman, vice-chairman and secretary. Persons appointed 11 as members shall be qualified voters of the state of 12 Wyoming with have special knowledge, as evidenced by 13 college degrees or courses, or with at least five (5) years experience in managerial positions, in the field of natural 14 associated natural resource 15 or production, gas 16 transportation, marketing or industrial consumption. Αt 17 least three (3) of the members shall be qualified voters of the state of Wyoming. Members of the board may receive the 18 19 same per diem, expenses and travel allowance as members of 20 the legislature while in actual attendance at meetings of 21 the board and the performance of their duties relative 22 thereto.

2 (a) As used in this act:

3

4 (i) "Associated natural resource" means any substance, element or compound, either gaseous, liquid or 5 6 solid, associated with the production, refining or 7 processing of crude oil, or natural gas, coal or coal byproducts. The term includes, but is not limited to, 8 9 propane, butanes, ethane, methane, carbon dioxide, sulphur, 10 helium, nitrogen, and natural gas liquids, synthetic fuels 11 and water related to energy production;

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
