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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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Section 1. W.S. 9-3-402(a) (xviii) is amended to read:

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13 **9-3-402.** Definitions.

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15 (a) As used in this article:

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(xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" 1 2 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county 3 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized 4 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the 5 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), 6 superintendent, assistant superintendent or full-time park 7 ranger of any state park or historic site meeting the specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(G), investigator 8 9 employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 10 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 11 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, Wyoming 12 law enforcement academy instructor, University of Wyoming 13 campus police officer, detention officer or dispatcher for 14 law enforcement agencies; 15 16 Section 2. 17 18

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superintendents, assistant (a) Coverage of superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or historic sites under W.S. 9-3-432 as provided by section 1 of this act shall not be implemented by the Wyoming retirement board until funds payable to the retirement system are received for deposit into the retirement account, as necessary for maintaining

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actuarial integrity of the account and funding all 1

2 liability arising under this act, for years of service

3 prior to the date of entry or expansion of coverage.

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5 (b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section, W.S. 9-3-432, with respect to superintendents, assistant 6 7 superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or historic sites, shall not be implemented by the Wyoming 8 9 retirement board until funds necessary for maintaining the actuarial integrity of the account and funding 10 11 liability arising under this act, are deposited into the 12 Wyoming retirement account by the Wyoming department of 13 state parks and cultural resources, and contributions required under W.S. 9-3-432(a) and (b) are paid to the 14 Wyoming retirement system for deposit into the retirement 15 account for at least two (2) months of covered service

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19 Section 3. There is appropriated three hundred fifty 20 thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) from the general fund to the 21 department of state parks and cultural resources to be 22 deposited in the retirement account as required by section 2 of this act to fund the liability arising under this act 23 24 for the coverage of superintendents, assistant

following the date of entry of coverage, as applicable.

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1	superintendents and full-time park rangers of state parks
2	or historic sites as provided in section 1 of this act.
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4	Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
