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17 (d) In addition to other remedies, in the event of a 18 continuing condition creating serious detriment to the 19 health, safety or welfare of recipients of home and 20 community based waiver services, the department may impose 21 a civil penalty upon the provider. The civil penalty shall 22 not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per day, and 23 shall be remitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the

    general fund except as otherwise provided by federal law
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    for Medicaid certified nursing facilities.
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         (e) The department shall have the same authority to
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    place conditions upon a provider, to impose a monitor or to
    revoke a certification issued under this section as
