- 11 (b)(intro) and by creating a new paragraph (vii) are

16 (a) As used in this article:

2 (v) "Passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle, 3 excluding emergency and law enforcement vehicles, designed 4 to carry people and that was equipped with safety belts at 5 the time of manufacture, + excluding: 6 7 (A) Emergency and law enforcement vehicles; 8 9 School buses as defined under W.S. (B) 10 31-5-102(a)(xlii), including buses registered to a private school or church used to transport children to or from 11 12 school or church or in connection with school or church 13 activities; 14 15 (C) Buses, or other vehicles designed and used for public transportation, whether intrastate or 16 17 interstate, that were not equipped with safety belts at the 18 time of manufacture. 19 31-5-1303. Child safety restraint system; required 20 21 use; exception. 22 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of 23 this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle 24

in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that 1 2 vehicle and who is eight (8) years of age or under, and who 3 weighs eighty (80) pounds or less, has not reached his 4 ninth birthday is properly secured in a child safety 5 restraint system in a seat of the vehicle other than the 6 front seat, except if the vehicle is only equipped with one 7 (1) row of seats, or if all safety belts in the rows of seats behind the front seat are in use by other child 8 9 passengers in the vehicle, the child may be properly secured in a child safety restraint system in the front 10 11 passenger seat of the vehicle, except that a rear-facing 12 infant seat shall not be placed in front of an active 13 airbag. 14 15 (b) Any child who is within the age and weight requirements specified in subsection (a) of this section 16 need not be properly secured in a child safety restraint 17 18 system if: 19 20 (vii) The lap and shoulder belts of the vehicle 21 will fit properly across the collarbone, chest and hips of 22 the child and the belts do not pose a danger to the neck, 23 face or abdominal area of the child in the event of a crash 24 or sudden stop.
