## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to charter schools; imposing requirements 2 for charter school facilities; modifying charter school 3 funding provisions and requiring school district provision 4 of services as specified; and providing for an effective date. 5 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 21-3-308(c) and 21-3-314(c)(intro), 10 (i)(intro), by creating a new paragraph (ii), by 11 renumbering (ii) as (iii) and (d) are amended to read: 12 21-3-308. Hearing by local board; prohibited actions 13 by local board; criteria; compliance with state standards; 14 15 state board review; contractual authority. 16

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1 (C) The district board shall require the applicant to 2 provide information regarding the proposed operation and 3 potential effects of the school, including but not limited 4 to the facilities to be utilized by the school, the 5 adequacy of facilities as defined by statewide standards established under W.S. 21-15-115, the manner in which 6 7 administrative services of the school are to be provided and a demonstration that the school is adequately insured 8 9 for liability, including errors and omissions coverage, and that the school district is indemnified to the fullest 10 11 extent possible. As authorized under subsection (a) of this 12 section, the applicant may request the district board and 13 the board may approve the charter application subject to specified conditions which provide the applicant sufficient 14 time to acquire necessary funding for securing or otherwise 15 16 finalizing arrangements for adequate facilities or 17 equipment necessary for the operation of the proposed school. In addition, The district board may upon request of 18 the applicant and approval of the charter school 19 20 application, make shall for charter schools approved after 21 July 1, 2005, subject to approval by the school facilities 22 commission and to the extent district facilities are 23 available for use by the charter school, locate the charter school in any district facility which is closed, not 24

operational and otherwise feasible for use as 1 an 2 educational building as defined under W.S. 3 21-15-109(a)(ii). Facilities shall not be leased for 4 operation of a charter school approved after July 1, 2005, 5 unless adequate district facilities are not available for 6 this purpose. 7 8 21-3-314. Students counted amount district ADM; 9 determination of charter school funding. 10 11 (c) Subject to subsection (d) of this section and as 12 part of the charter school contract, the charter school and 13 the school district shall agree on funding and any services to be provided by the school district to the charter 14 school. The charter school and the school district shall 15 begin discussions on the contract using the following 16 17 revenue assumptions: 18 (i) The charter school shall be entitled to the 19 20 benefit of ninety-five percent (95%) of the foundation 21 program amount computed under the appropriate prototypical school model level specified under W.S. 21-13-309(p) based 22 upon 21-13-309(m) (ii) for the average daily membership of 23

24 the charter school, less:

1	(ii) Excluding adjustments provided under W.S.
2	21-13-309(n)(i), (ii), (ix) and (x), the charter school
3	shall to the extent the school qualifies for each separate
4	adjustment, be entitled to the benefit of ninety-five
5	percent (95%) of the adjustments to the prototypical amount
6	as prescribed under W.S. 21-13-309(n) and (o) based upon
7	the average daily membership, relevant student populations
8	and employees of the charter school as applicable to each
9	specific model adjustment;

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(iii) (iii) The charter school shall be entitled 11 12 to the benefit of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount to be contributed to the school district under major 13 maintenance payments pursuant to W.S. 21-15-109 based upon 14 the proportion that the charter school educational building 15 16 square footage contributes to the qross district 17 educational building gross square footage.

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(d) The charter school may also contract with the school district for centralized services provided by the district including curriculum, media services, and libraries. and federally required educational services such as special education. The district shall provide transportation of charter school children as provided under

1	W.S. 21-13-320(b)(i), (ii), special education programs and
2	services as defined under W.S. 21-13-321(a)(ii) and
3	isolation and maintenance as provided under W.S. 21-4-401
4	for the charter school at the expense of the district.
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6	Section 2. W.S. 21-3-314(e) is repealed.
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8	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
