(b) In carrying out subsection (a) of this section 1 2 and except as provided under the Wyoming Medical Assistance 3 and Services Act, the department shall: 4 5 (xiii) Provide benefits under the personal opportunities with employment responsibilities (POWER) 6 7 program and the food stamp program to individuals who have a felony conviction for possession, use or distribution of 8 9 a controlled substance, as allowed under section 114 of 10 P.L. 104-193; 11 12 (xiv) Promulgate and adopt rules and 13 regulations necessary to carry out this article; 14 15 (xiv) (xv) Subject to the availability of funds, 16 provide to recipients in an approved education program 17 under W.S. 42-2-109(a) at least two (2) hours of dependent day care, if needed, for each hour the applicant is 18 required to be in class, laboratory or other required 19 20 instructional activity. 21 Section 2.
