- 13 the legislature shall receive seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)
- 14 per day as salary and thirty-five cents (\$.35) per mile for
- 15 necessary travel to attend and return from the legislature.
- 16 From and after January 9, 1995, each member of the

legislature shall receive one hundred twenty-five dollars 1 2 (\$125.00) per day as salary in addition to the mileage rate provided for in this subsection. From and after January 3, 3 4 2005, each member of the legislature shall receive one 5 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per day as salary in 6 addition to the mileage rate provided for in this 7 subsection. From and after the first Monday in January, 2009, each member of the legislature shall receive a 8 9 mileage rate calculated as follows: 10 11 (i) Forty and one-half cents per mile (\$.405) as 12 adjusted annually on January 1 beginning January 1, 2006, 13 by the Wyoming cost-of-living index as determined by the 14 division of economic analysis of the department of administration and information. 15 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 17 18
