1 AN ACT relating to highways; providing funding for four-  
2 lane highways as specified; and providing for an effective

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-601(d)(iv) and by creating new  
8 paragraphs (v) and (vi) is amended to read:

10 **9-4-601. Distribution and use; funds, accounts,**  
11 **cities and towns benefited; exception for bonus payments.**

13 (d) Any revenue received under subsection (a) of this  
14 section in excess of two hundred million dollars  
15 (\$200,000,000.00) shall be distributed as follows:

(iv) ~~Two-thirds (2/3)~~ Fifty-six and one-third percent (56.33%) to the budget reserve account;~~;~~

(v) Eight and one-third percent (8.33%) to the highway fund to be expended by the transportation commission for engineering, constructing and maintaining four-lane highways in this state as identified by the department of transportation with priority given to roads and highways impacted by mineral development. Interest earned by the revenue deposited in the fund shall be retained in the fund and may be used for maintenance on four-lane state highways;

(vi) Two percent (2%) to the highway fund to be expended by the transportation commission for maintenance of state highways in this state. Interest earned by the revenue deposited in the fund shall be retained in the fund.

**Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
