The department reorganization plan, as approved, 15 shall be submitted to the joint appropriations interim 16 committee and the select management audit committee of the 17 legislature and made available to the public. The committees shall hold at least one (1) public hearing 18 regarding the plan before the 1991 session of the 19 legislature convenes. The select management audit committee 20 21 shall report its advisory recommendations on the plan to 22 joint appropriations interim committee, including 23 necessary legislation with respect to the plan. The joint 24 appropriations interim committee shall consider

1 recommendations and shall report to the legislature by

- 2 December 1, 1990, its recommendations on the plan,
- 3 including necessary legislation with respect to the plan.
- 4 The plan, as approved by act of the legislature, shall be
- 5 implemented not later than July 1, 1991. Pending adoption
- 6 of the plan, the state library, archives, museums and

- 8 of administration for administration of the state library.
