(iii) For the purpose of exempting sales of 1 2 services and tangible personal property consumed in 3 production, the following are exempt: 4 5 (B) Sales of livestock, feeds for use in feeding livestock or poultry for marketing purposes and 6 7 seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants and fertilizer, herbicide and pesticide planted or applied to land, the products of 8 9 which are to be sold. This exemption applies to, but is 10 not limited to, sales of seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants 11 and fertilizer, herbicide and pesticide planted or applied 12 to land subject to a state or federal crop set aside 13 program; 14 15 39-16-105. (B) Purchases of livestock, feeds for use 1 2 in feeding livestock or poultry for marketing purposes and 3 seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants and fertilizer, herbicide and pesticide planted or applied to land, the products of 4 which are to be sold. This exemption applies to, but is 5 not limited to, sales of seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants 6 7 and fertilizer, herbicide and pesticide planted or applied to land subject to a state or federal crop set aside 8 9 program; 10 11 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 14
