## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to contagious and infectious diseases; 1 2 providing for sale of cattle or domestic bison infected with or exposed to brucellosis; amending the payment for 3 4 the slaughter of livestock affected with tuberculosis; providing for brucellosis testing and surveillance 5 as 6 specified; providing a penalty; and providing an effective date. 7

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 9

Section 1. W.S. 11-19-406 is created to read: 11

11-19-406. Sale of diseased cattle or domestic bison. 13

- All cattle or domestic bison in Wyoming lawfully found to 15
- 16 be affected with brucellosis, including all sexually intact

cattle or domestic bison that are part of a herd found to 1

- 2 be affected with brucellosis, may be shipped or transported
- 3 under the direction of the state veterinarian to livestock
- 4 markets and sold for immediate slaughter or transferred to
- 5 an approved slaughter facility in accordance with federal
- regulations. 6

- 8 **Section 2.** W.S. 11-19-214 and 11-19-405 by creating
- 9 new subsections (c) through (f) are amended to read:

11 11-19-214. Sale of diseased livestock.

- 13 All cattle—livestock in Wyoming lawfully found to be
- affected with either tuberculosis or Bang's disease may be 14
- shipped or transported under the direction of the state 15
- veterinarian in accordance with federal regulations, to 16
- 17 livestock markets and there sold for salvage and destroyed
- or transferred to an approved slaughter facility in 18
- 19 accordance with federal regulations. The owner of condemned
- 20 cattle livestock shall receive the entire proceeds for such
- 21 sale be paid the difference between the market value at the
- 22 time of quarantine and the amount received for the sale,
- less any amount of reimbursement provided for and paid 23
- under federal law or regulation, less the cost of shipping 24

or transportation and commission charges. If the net

salvage obtained from the cattle does not equal their

assessed valuation for the year preceding the date of

condemnation and shipping, the difference between the sale

monies and the assessed valuation shall be paid to the

owner of the cattle from an appropriation for that purpose.

8 11-19-405. Control of brucellosis; governor 9 authorized to negotiate with federal agencies.

c) In the event of a confirmed outbreak of brucellosis, the governor may authorize the state veterinarian, with the approval of the Wyoming livestock board, to require brucellosis testing of all test eligible bovine or domestic bison at the farm or ranch of origin or any licensed Wyoming livestock market prior to a change of ownership for a period of up to eighteen (18) months. At the end of the required testing period, the state veterinarian shall review the testing requirement and may reimpose brucellosis testing for one (1) or more successive periods under this subsection if there is deemed a threat to Wyoming's brucellosis free status or if the state is designated as brucellosis class A or lower status.

1	(d) The state veterinarian may direct any Wyoming
2	brand inspector to withhold a brand inspection for movement
3	or change of ownership to any person who has not shown
4	evidence of any required brucellosis test.
5	
6	(e) As part of the state brucellosis surveillance and
7	prevention program, the state veterinarian may require
8	brucellosis testing at any licensed Wyoming livestock
9	market at any time. Failure to comply shall result in a
10	suspension of the livestock market's license.
11	
12	(f) Any person who violates any provision of this
13	section shall be punished as provided by W.S. 11-1-103.
14	
15	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
16	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
17	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
18	Constitution.
