AN ACT relating to the Wyoming professional assistance program; extending program provisions to attorneys; providing for disclosure of records to licensing agency upon refusal of treatment; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 33-1-115(a)(ii), (iii) and (d) by creating a new paragraph (vi) is amended to read:

33-1-115. Professional assistance programs for health care providers and others as specified; confidentiality of records.

- (a) As used in this section:
- (ii) "Licensee" means any individual holding a permit or license as a health care provider as a profession or occupation regulated under this title or any individual admitted to the Wyoming state bar;
- (iii) "Professional assistance program" or "program" means a program or activity relating to drug or alcohol abuse prevention, referral, treatment or rehabilitation, which is directly or indirectly assisted by a board or commission or other organization established under this title for the regulation of licensees or the Wyoming state bar.
- (d) Whether or not the licensee gives his written consent, the content of the record may be disclosed as follows:

(vi) To the state board or commission regulating the licensee, if the diagnosis or prognosis determines a clearly definable drug or alcohol abuse problem and the licensee refuses to seek treatment.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
