A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming

2 Constitution to authorize the establishment of inviolate

3 trust funds for higher education; and authorizing the

4 investment and use of earnings from such funds.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,

7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting

8 separately, concurring therein:

10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming

11 Constitution, Article 15 by creating a new section 20 is

12 proposed for submission to the electors of the State of

13 Wyoming at the next general election for approval or

14 rejection to become valid as a part of the Constitution if

15 ratified by a majority of the electors at the election:

2 Article 15, Section 20. Higher education trust funds;

3 investments; earnings.

4

5 The legislature may from time to time place monies into

6 endowment funds for higher education scholarships and for

7 improving the quality and quantity of higher education,

8 which funds shall remain inviolate. The earnings of the

9 funds shall be used for the purposes specified in this

10 section, but the legislature may from time to time by law

11 regulated the manner in which the earnings are expended.

12 The legislature may also provide for use of the earnings to

13 protect the funds from inflation and to even fluctuations

14 in earnings over time. The funds may be invested in the

15 same manner as other permanent funds of the state.

16

17 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse

18 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

19

20 This amendment authorizes the creation of permanent funds

21 for two purposes: First, higher education scholarships;

22 and second, improving the quality and quantity of higher

23 education. The principal in the funds cannot be used. The

24 earnings must be used for the purposes specified and the

1 legislature is authorized to pass laws regulating how the 2 earnings are used. In the 2005 legislative session the legislature created a formula to provided one hundred five 3 million dollars (\$105,000,000.00) for an endowment for 4 excellence in higher education and four hundred million 5 6 dollars (\$400,000,000.00) for higher education 7 scholarships. It is the intention of the legislature to 8 use the earnings of the scholarship endowment to ensure 9 that every Wyoming high school student who performs well 10 has the practical opportunity to go to college. The 11 legislature has also from time to time appropriated funds 12 which become part of endowments if matched by private 13 contributions. This amendment would protect these 14 endowment funds from raids for other purposes. The legislature also believes that allowing the funds to be 15 16 invested the same way other state permanent funds 17 invested will improve the earnings available for use.
