A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming livestock board; providing
- 2 for conducting business electronically; modifying the
- 3 structure of the board; authorizing a position of executive
- 4 officer of the board; modifying duties; increasing the
- 5 compensation of the board; providing an appropriation; and
- 6 providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-18-118 is created to read:

12 11-18-118. Conducting business electronically.

- 14 The Wyoming livestock board may allow its business to be
- 15 conducted electronically as provided by the Uniform

- 1 Electronic Transactions Act, W.S. 40-21-101 through
- 2 40-20-119.

- 4 Section 2. W.S. 11-1-103, 11-18-101(a), 11-18-103(a),
- 5 by creating a new paragraph (i) and by renumbering
- 6 paragraphs (i) through (vii) as (ii) through (viii),
- 7 11-18-106 and 11-18-110 are amended to read:

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9 11-1-103. Penalty for violations.

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- 11 A person who violates any of the following sections commits
- 12 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than
- 13 six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty
- 14 dollars (\$750.00), or both for the first offense, or by
- 15 imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, a fine of not
- 16 more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00), or
- 17 both for second or subsequent offenses: W.S. 11-6-210(a) or
- 18 (f), 11-18-112, 11-19-101, 11-19-102, 11-19-111, 11-19-401,
- 19 11-20-114, 11-20-117, 11-20-229, 11-21-104, 11-22-118,
- 20 11-23-106, 11-23-207, 11-24-106 and 11-30-114. A person who
- 21 violates board rules promulgated pursuant to W.S.
- 22 $\frac{11-18-103(a)(v)}{21-18-103(a)(vi)}$ shall be subject to the
- 23 penalties specified in this section.

1 11-18-101. Livestock board; creation; composition;
2 qualifications; appointment and term of members; removal;
3 vacancies; name defined.

4

5 (a) The Wyoming livestock board is created and shall consist of three (3) woolgrowers and four (4) stockmen 6 7 engaged in other seven (7) livestock interests producers. They shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and 8 9 consent of the senate and may be removed by the governor as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. The members shall be appointed 10 from each of the appointment districts pursuant to W.S. 11 9-1-218 and the appointment for each district shall be 12 13 rotated among the counties within the district. The members 14 shall serve for one (1) six (6) year term and until their 15 successors are appointed and qualified. In case of a vacancy for any reason, the governor shall appoint a 16 17 qualified person to fill the vacancy in accordance with 18 W.S. 28-12-101. Each member of the Wyoming livestock board 19 shall be a qualified elector of the county from which he is 20 appointed and a resident of this state during his term of 21 office.

23 11-18-103. Livestock board; powers generally.

In addition to powers and duties hereinafter 1 (a) provided, the Wyoming livestock board may: 2 3 4 (i) Appoint a director, who shall be the chief 5 executive officer of the board; 6 (i) (ii) Appoint a state veterinarian who is a 7 graduate of a recognized veterinary college and licensed to 8 practice in Wyoming, who shall be the chief executive 9 officer of the board; 10 11 12 (ii) (iii) Appoint deputy state veterinarians, agents and assistants who shall act under the direction of 13 14 the Wyoming livestock board and its chief executive officer: 15 (A) Deputy state veterinarians must 16 17 graduates of a veterinary college recognized by American Veterinary Medical Association and the state board 18 19 of veterinary medicine. 20 (iii)(iv) Supervise and control the action of 21 22 its chief executive officer, the director and the state veterinarian, all deputies and other employees 23 and 24 prescribe their duties and tenure of office;

2 (iv)(v) Remove any of its appointees, 3 subordinates or employees the director or the state 4 veterinarian at any time for cause; 5 (v)(vi) Promulgate and enforce rules, 6 7 regulations and orders it deems necessary for the importation of domestic animals, excluding those animals 8 9 covered in W.S. 23-3-301(a), recording and inspection of livestock brands, inspection, testing, brucellosis 10 vaccination or quarantining of any livestock including 11 12 brucellosis vaccination requirements for resident cattle 13 and cattle imported into Wyoming; 14 (vi)(vii) Exercise the power and authority 15 conferred upon it by this act, either directly or through 16 17 its agency; and 18 19 (vii) (viii) Designate an agency to act as its 20 representative as provided by W.S. 11-20-201, recorded in

21 its minutes, and transmit the name of the agency to the 22 auditor and treasurer of Wyoming.

24 11-18-106. Livestock board; quorum; compensation. 1

2 A majority of the board constitutes a quorum for the

3 transaction of business. Members of the board shall receive

4 compensation at the rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day

5 salary, mileage and per diem for time actually spent in the

6 performance of their duties and traveling expenses while in

7 attendance, and going to and from board meetings in the

8 same manner and amount as provided for state employees by

9 W.S. 9-3-102 members of the Wyoming legislature.

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11 11-18-110. Director; deputy directors; term; powers

12 and duties generally; orders subject to review.

13

14 (a) The chief executive officer director shall serve

15 at the pleasure of and act as the secretary of the Wyoming

16 livestock board, subject to the rules and regulations of

17 the board. He may act for and perform the duties imposed by

18 law upon the board when the board is not in session, but an

19 order or regulation made by him is subject to review,

20 modification or annulment by the board at any subsequent

21 meeting.

1	(b) The director shall supervise and control the
2	action of the deputy directors and other employees and
3	prescribe their duties and tenure of office.
4	
5	(c) The director may appoint deputy directors for
6	agency divisions. The deputy directors shall serve at the
7	pleasure of the director and are responsible to and under
8	the control and supervision of the director.
9	
10	Section 3. There is appropriated from the general
11	fund to the livestock board two hundred fifty thousand
12	dollars (\$250,000.00) to fund the director position
13	pursuant to this act.
14	
15	Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2006.
