10	and (e), and 9-1-634 are amended to read:
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12	7-4-208. Authority of sheriff to perform duties of
13	coroner.
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1	If there is no coroner, deputy coroner or in case of their
2	absence, or inability to act, the county sheriff of the
3	same county, or the state health officer pursuant to W.S.
4	35-1-241, or the coroner of another county if there is a
5	joint powers agreement pursuant to W.S. 16-1-102 through
б	16-1-108 between the counties authorizing the coroner to so
7	act, is authorized to perform the duties of coroner in
8	relation to dead bodies.
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10	7-4-211. Board of coroner standards.
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12	(b) The members of the board shall be appointed to
13	terms of four (4) years which are concurrent with the terms
14	of the office of coroner. Board members who are not elected
15	county officers or employees of a government agency <u>not</u>
16	otherwise compensated for attending board meetings shall
17	receive travel expenses and per diem in the same manner and
18	amount as state employees <mark>, and any other reasonable</mark>
19	expenses upon board approval. Board members not otherwise
20	compensated shall have their expenses paid from the general
21	fund by appropriation to the office of the attorney

Academy to provide coroner training; certification of completion. 16 17 18 (a) The director of the Wyoming law enforcement academy may shall provide at the academy or other location 19 20 within the state a basic coroner's course of forty (40) 21 twenty (20) hours. The course shall comply with standards 22 promulgated by the peace officers standards and training 23 commission and the board of coroner standards.
