- 10 (a) The question of whether the state should
- 11 participate in a multi-state lottery shall be submitted to
- 12 electors at the 2006 general election and the secretary of
- 13 state shall certify the following nonbinding proposition on
- 14 the ballot after other propositions in the following
- 15 format:

1	Nonbinding Ballot Proposition
2	
3	This is a nonbinding ballot proposition. It has
4	no legal effect but is intended to assist the
5	legislature in assessing public support for the
6	proposition printed below. Regardless of whether
7	the public votes in support of this proposition,
8	the legislature will have an opportunity to
9	consider legislation regarding the proposition.
10	
11	Should the state enter into a multi-state
12	lottery?

16	Section 2. The nonbinding ballot proposition in W.S.
17	40-24-101(b) of this act is intended to provide the voters
18	an opportunity to express their opinion regarding the
19	proposition proposed by the act so that any subsequent
20	legislature has an opportunity to enact legislation with
21	the understanding of the will of the people of the state.
22	
23	Section 3. There is appropriated from the general
24	fund to the secretary of state's office eighteen thousand

dollars (\$18,000.00) for the purposes of placing the 1

2 nonbinding referendum provided by section 1 of this act on

3 the 2006 general election ballot.

5 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 6

7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

Constitution. 8
