5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-25-102(a)(v), (vii)(intro), (D)
- 8 and by creating a new subparagraph (E) and 11-25-105(b)(ii)
- 9 and by creating a new paragraph (iii) are amended to read:

11 **11-25-102.** Definitions.

13 (a) As used in this act:

14

- 15 (v) "Pari-mutuel event" means the events which
- 16 are authorized by the commission for the conduct of horse

racing (to include quarter horse, thoroughbred or other 1 approved races), harness racing, cutter racing, chariot 2 racing, chuckwagon racing, professional roping events and 3 4 simulcasting of dog racing and the events described in this 5 paragraph as prescribed by the commission. Notwithstanding W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iv) and 11-25-107, the commission may 6 7 authorize and promulgate rules providing for pari-mutuel wagering on events that have previously occurred, utilizing 8 9 a terminal connected to an electronic pari-mutuel system or 10 device; 11 12 (vii) "Simulcasting" means the sale of 13 pari-mutuel pools on electronically transmitted live or 14 historic interstate or intrastate televised pari-mutuel 15 events as prescribed by the commission. The commission 16 shall authorize simulcasting subject to the following 17 conditions: 18 19 The commission shall promulgate rules 20 for conducting simulcasting as are reasonably necessary to 21 protect the public interest; - and 22 (E) Electronically transmitted historic 23 24 pari-mutuel events shall be subject to the following:

2 (I) The events shall be conducted by a 3 holder of a permit issued under this act via a commission 4 approved terminal connected to an electronic pari-mutuel 5 system or device; 6 7 (II) The events shall be limited to wagering at no more than thirty (30) terminals at any one 8

11 (III) The events shall be limited to

12 one (1) simulcast location per county in which simulcasting

13 has been approved pursuant to W.S. 11-25-110.

15 11-25-105. Pari-mutuel permits; fees and reports; 16 disposition of funds; enforcement of provisions.

18 (b) Every Wednesday following any pari-mutuel event, 19 the permittee shall:

21 (ii) Pay an amount equal to one and one-half 22 percent (1 1/2%) of the total amount wagered on any live or any live simulcast event shown by the report to the 23 24 commission to be credited by the state treasurer to a

4	(iii) Pay an amount equal to one-half percent
5	(1/2%) of the total amount wagered on any historic
6	simulcast event shown by the report to the commission to be
7	credited by the state treasurer to a separate account, in
8	the manner indicated in subsection (d) of this section.
