## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT providing an appropriation for the alleviation of
- 2 specified conditions on the Wind River Indian Reservation
- 3 through education programs; imposing conditions upon the
- 4 expenditure of appropriated funds; transferring funds to
- 5 the governor's office; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

11 (a) The legislature finds that:

12

- 13 (i) Conditions of severe unemployment, poverty
- 14 and lack of adequate job skills exist on the Wind River
- 15 Indian Reservation;

16

17 (ii) Educational programs provided by the

1 Eastern Shoshone and the Northern Arapaho Indian Tribes

2 address these conditions on the reservation;

3

4 (iii) The Shoshone and Arapaho Indian Tribes are

5 sovereign nations whose members are also citizens of the

United States and residents of Wyoming; 6

7

(iv) With assistance from the state of Wyoming, 8

9 the joint business council of the Eastern Shoshone and

10 Northern Arapaho Indian Tribes will be capable

11 continuing efforts to address conditions existing on the

12 reservation through the provision of programs addressing

13 the special educational needs of Indian students.

maintenance of these special educational programs unique to 14

Indian students is of mutual benefit to the tribes and to 15

16 the state, reducing future financial needs of those

17 students as tribal members and as Wyoming residents for

public education, job services, substance abuse services 18

19 and income supplements.

20

21 (b) Twenty-six thousand three hundred sixteen dollars

22 (\$26,316.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the

office of the governor for the biennium to be used for a 23

24 cost of living increase to the budget for Saint Stephens

school. One-half (1/2) of the funds shall be used for each 1

2 year of the biennium. The office of the governor shall

3 provide the funds under this section through amendment of

4 existing contracts or creation of new contracts with the

5 joint business council of the Eastern Shoshone and Northern

Arapaho Indian Tribes whereby the funds appropriated under 6

this section shall be conveyed to the joint business 7

council to be expended by the joint business council for 8

9 program enhancements, services for students at risk of

failure in school and other services essential to the 10

11 success and welfare of students.

12

13 There is transferred to the office

governor from the department of education three hundred 14

eighty-four thousand one hundred ten dollars (\$384,110.00) 15

for funding for Saint Stephens school. This transfer shall 16

17 be a type 1 transfer, pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1707(b)(i) and

shall include the transfer of all positions, personnel, 18

property, contracts and funds associated with the funds 19

20 appropriated under this section.

21

22 (d) As part of the contract the joint business

council shall agree to report to the joint appropriations 23

24 interim committee, the joint education interim committee

and the select committee on tribal relations on the 1

2 expenditure of funds under this section and on the impact

of the expenditures on student performance. The report 3

4 shall be made not later than June 30, 2007.

5

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2006. 6
