Hospitals-participation in state retirement.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming retirement system; allowing
2 county and special district hospitals to participate in the
3 retirement system; prohibiting participation in multiple
4 retirement programs as specified; amending a definition;
5 conditioning implementation upon receipt of required
6 payments; providing for funding; and providing for an
7 effective date.

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9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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11 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-402(a)(vi)(B) and 9-3-427 are
12 amended to read:

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14 **9-3-402. Definitions.**

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16 (a) As used in this article:

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2 (vi) "Employer" or "participating employer"

3 means:

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5 (B) Any county, ~~except~~ county memorial
6 ~~hospitals or hospital,~~ special hospital ~~districts~~ district,
7 city or town or legally constituted department designated
8 to the board by the appropriate governing body as an
9 employer under this article;

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11 **9-3-427. Other retirement plans prohibited.**

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13 The establishment of any annuity plan, limited service
14 plan, pension or retirement system other than that provided
15 by this article by any department, board, bureau or agency
16 of the state or by any political subdivision of the state
17 is prohibited, except this prohibition does not apply to
18 the Wyoming state highway patrol, game and fish warden and
19 criminal investigator retirement program. Any county
20 memorial hospital or special hospital district that elects
21 to participate in the state retirement system shall not
22 otherwise participate in any other retirement system.

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24 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-3-402(a)(vii)(F)(III) is repealed.

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4 (a) Coverage of county hospital or special hospital
5 district employees as authorized under section 1 of this
6 act shall not be implemented by the Wyoming retirement
7 board until funds payable to the Wyoming retirement system
8 are received for deposit into the retirement account, as
9 necessary for maintaining the actuarial integrity of the
10 account and funding all liability arising under this act,
11 for years of service prior to the date of entry or
12 expansion of coverage.

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14 (b) Any county memorial hospital or special hospital
15 district may elect to participate in the Wyoming retirement
16 system by providing written notice to the Wyoming
17 retirement board of its election under this subsection.

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19 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
