AN ACT relating to child support enforcement; eliminating the requirement that the cost of mailing a notice of income withholding is the responsibility of the obligee; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1 W.S. 20-6-203 is amended to read:

20-6-203. Notices; method of service.

All notices required by this act shall be served by certified mail return receipt requested to the last known address of the addressee or shall be personally served as provided by the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure. If mailed, notice shall be deemed given when deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid. Proof of mailing shall be sufficient proof of notice. The cost of mailing the notice is the responsibility of the obligee.
