for

1 AN ACT relating to the board of agriculture; modifying the  
2 board composition; extending the board membership term;  
3 increasing the compensation as provided; providing an  
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-2-102 and 11-2-104 are amended to  
9 read:

10

11 **11-2-102. Composition; qualifications; appointment**  
12 **and removal of members; quorum.**

13

14 (a) The board shall consist of ~~nine (9)~~ thirteen (13)  
15 members, including the governor and the dean of the

1 University of Wyoming college of agriculture or his  
2 designated representative as ex officio nonvoting members.  
3 ~~Seven (7)~~ Eleven (11) voting members shall be appointed by  
4 the governor with the advice and consent of the senate and  
5 may be removed by the governor as provided in W.S. 9-1-202.

6  
7 (b) One (1) member shall be appointed from each of  
8 the seven (7) appointment districts pursuant to W.S.  
9 9-1-218. Appointments in each appointment district shall be  
10 rotated among the several counties comprising the district.

11  
12 ~~(b)~~ (c) Appointed members shall be appointed for a  
13 term of ~~four (4)~~ six (6) years.

14  
15 (d) The seven (7) members appointed from the ~~various~~  
16 appointment districts:

17  
18 (i) Shall be selected to represent a  
19 cross-section of the agricultural industry; ~~and~~

20  
21 (ii) Shall be engaged chiefly in agricultural  
22 work; ~~and~~

1           (iii) Not more than four (4) shall be members of  
2 the same political party.

3  
4           (e) One (1) member shall be appointed from each of  
5 the four (4) board of agriculture youth leadership  
6 quadrants as follows:

7  
8           (i) The northeast quadrant shall consist of  
9 Campbell, Crook, Johnson, Niobrara, Sheridan and Weston  
10 counties;

11  
12           (ii) The northwest quadrant shall consist of Big  
13 Horn, Hot Springs, Park, Teton and Washakie counties;

14  
15           (iii) The southeast quadrant shall consist of  
16 Albany, Converse, Goshen, Laramie, Natrona and Platte  
17 counties; and

18  
19           (iv) The southwest quadrant shall consist of  
20 Carbon, Fremont, Lincoln, Sublette, Sweetwater and Uinta  
21 counties.

22  
23           (f) The four (4) members appointed from the board of  
24 agriculture youth leadership quadrants:

2 (i) Shall be selected to represent a  
3 cross-section of the agricultural industry;

4

5 (ii) Shall be engaged chiefly in agricultural  
6 work; and

7

8 (iii) Shall be between eighteen (18) and thirty  
9 (30) years of age at the time of submitting the application  
10 for board membership.

11

12 ~~(e)~~(g) A majority of the appointed members of the  
13 board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.

14

15 ~~(d)~~(h) Effective July 1, 1979, appointments and terms  
16 shall be in accordance with W.S. 28-12-101 through  
17 28-12-103.

19 **11-2-104. Salary and expenses; oath; election of**  
20 **president and vice-president.**

21

22 The board members, except the governor and the dean of the  
23 University of Wyoming college of agriculture, shall be paid  
24 ~~ten dollars (\$10.00) per day when acting in their official~~

1 ~~capacity and shall be reimbursed for traveling expenses as~~  
2 ~~provided by W.S. 9-3-102 for state employees~~ the salary,  
3 for attending and traveling to and from official board  
4 business in the same manner and amount as members of the  
5 Wyoming legislature and the mileage and per diem for  
6 attending and traveling to and from official board business  
7 in the same manner and amount as state employees. The  
8 appointed board members, within a reasonable time after  
9 their appointment, shall qualify by taking the  
10 constitutional oath of office and filing it with the  
11 secretary of state. The appointed members shall elect from  
12 their members a president and vice-president.

13

14 **Section 2.** There is appropriated from the general  
15 fund to the department of agriculture fifty thousand  
16 dollars (\$50,000.00) for the purpose of implementing this  
17 act.

18

19 **Section 3.** W.S. 11-2-102(f) shall not apply to  
20 members of the board of agriculture appointed prior to the  
21 effective date of this act, but shall apply to members of  
22 the board of agriculture appointed after the effective date  
23 of this act.
