A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the wheat marketing commission; reducing
- 2 the membership of the commission; removing area
- 3 restrictions for appointments to the commission; modifying
- 4 other criteria for commission membership; and providing for
- 5 an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-38-102(a) and (c) and 11-38-103
- 10 are amended to read:

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- 12 11-38-102. Establishment; composition; appointment;
- 13 removal; officers; consultation permitted; area
- 14 distribution of nominations.

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The wheat marketing commission is established 1 (a) 2 consisting of $\frac{\text{seven}}{\text{(7)}}$ five (5) members appointed by the 3 governor from nominations made by the Wyoming wheat growers 4 association or any other duly organized and incorporated 5 state organization within the state of Wyoming having a commodity division working with wheat. The director of the 6 7 department of agriculture or his designated representative shall serve ex officio. The governor may remove any member 8 9 he appoints as provided in W.S. 9-1-202.

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11 (c) All appointed members shall derive their main 12 substantial income from the growing of wheat, based on 13 historical records. The nominations shall be submitted from the following areas: Area I - Niobrara, Goshen, Platte, 14 Laramie; Area II - Sheridan, Johnson, Campbell, Crook, 15 16 Weston, Carbon, Converse, Natrona, Fremont, Park, Teton, Hot Springs, Big Horn, Washakie, Sublette, Uinta and 17 Lincoln. Each nomination shall include a resume of the 18 nominee's qualifications for serving on the commission. 19 20 There shall be four (4) commission members from Area I and 21 three (3) commission members from Area II.

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11-38-103. Terms of office. 23

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(a) The terms of office for the initial wheat 1 2 commission members shall be three (3) terms of one (1) year 3 each, two (2) terms of two (2) years each and two (2) terms 4 of three (3) years each. Subsequent appointments will be 5 for terms of three (3) years. 6 7 (b) To reduce the commission from seven (7) members to five (5) members, the commission shall be reduced by the 8 9 two (2) positions that are vacant as of October 1, 2006. 10 11 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 13 Constitution. 14
