## A BILL

1	AN ACT relating to water; providing for the Town of
2	Pinedale to release water stored in Fremont Lake for
3	purposes of instream flow as a pilot project; requiring a
4	report; providing a sunset date; and providing for an
5	effective date.
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7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. W.S. 41-3-1015 is created to read:
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11	41-3-1015. Pilot project providing for instream flow;
12	restrictions; report requirement; sunset date.
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14	(a) A pilot project shall be established to allow the Town
15	of Pinedale to release up to four thousand eight hundred

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1 (4,800) acre-feet of water, if available and properly stored under reservoir permit number 4452, in any one (1) 2 3 water year. Notwithstanding the requirements of W.S. 41-3-4 1002 (e), the state engineer shall allow and protect the 5 releases with the following restrictions: 6 7 (i) The release shall not violate the provisions of W.S. 41-3-1006(g) or (h) or W.S. 41-3-1014; 8 9 10 (ii) The release shall not injure the water rights of any other lawful appropriator; 11 12 13 (iii) The stream segment in which the instream 14 flow shall apply shall coincide with the stream segment identified in existing instream flow permit numbers 33 and 15 34 on Pine Creek from Fremont Lake to the mouth of Pine 16 17 Creek; 18 (iv) Measurement of the instream flow releases 19 20 provided under this section shall be performed at the same 21 point of measurement established for existing instream flow 22 permits on Pine Creek. If the state engineer deems additional measuring devices are required, the measuring 23

1 devices shall be constructed by the game and fish 2 commission pursuant to W.S. 41-3-1003; 3 4 (v) A specific water use agreement shall be 5 executed between the Town of Pinedale, the game and fish commission and the water development commission for the 6 period of this pilot project. The agreement shall allow 7 the water development commission to request regulation on 8 9 behalf of water released under this section pursuant to

12 (vi) The total amount of stream flow to be 13 protected as instream flow at the point or points of 14 measurement shall not exceed forty (40) cubic feet of water 15 per second of time, which includes the combined flow rates 16 already in the channel of Pine Creek by virtue of existing 17 instream flow permit numbers 33 or 34, as well as releases 18 made under this section;

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20 (vii) The Town of Pinedale shall be responsible 21 for removal of physical obstructions, if any, at the outlet 22 of Fremont Lake that inhibit the ability to release water 23 under reservoir permit number 4452 into Pine Creek.

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(b) No permanent instream flow water right shall be 1 2 conferred upon the releases made and protected as instream 3 flow under this pilot project.

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5 (c) This section is repealed effective September 30, 2011. 6

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8 Section 2. No later than December 31, 2011, the state 9 engineer shall report to the governor, the joint agriculture, public lands and water resources interim 10 11 committee and the select water committee on the operations 12 and results of this pilot project.

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14 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 16 Constitution. 17
