Direct supervision of pesticide applications.

A BILL

for

1	AN ACT relating to pesticide control; specifying
2	requirements for direct supervision of pesticide
3	application; providing a definition; requiring training;
4	and providing for an effective date.
5	
6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	
8	Section 1. W.S. 35-7-376 is created to read:
9	
10	35-7-376. Direct Supervision.
11	
12	(a) Any person applying a pesticide under direct
13	supervision shall be within one hundred (100) miles of the
14	supervising certified applicator and shall possess
15	validation of training from the certified applicator in the

proper use and handling of pesticides. This training shall
 be provided annually.

4 (b) When a certified applicator maintains a physical
5 business presence in multiple locations, each business
6 location shall employ a certified applicator.

7

8 (c) The certified applicator shall be available at 9 all times for immediate contact by telephone or radio or 10 shall be physically present on-site when any pesticide is 11 used that poses a serious hazard or threat to humans, 12 animals or the environment.

(d) Any certified applicator applying any pesticide for payment or hire in Wyoming shall hold a Wyoming pesticide applicators license and shall be physically present within Wyoming when any pesticide application is made. This person may employ subordinates and shall comply with the direct supervision required by this section.

Section 2. W.S. 35-7-354 by creating a new subsection (d) and by renumbering subsections (d) and (e) as (e) and (f) is amended to read:

3	(d) "Direct supervision" means, unless otherwise
4	prescribed by the pesticide labeling, the act or process
5	where any application of a pesticide is made by a competent
6	person, acting under the instructions and control of a
7	certified applicator who is responsible for the actions of
8	the person applying the pesticide, even though the
9	certified applicator is not physically present at the time
10	and place the pesticide is applied;
11	
12	(d) (e) "Pesticide" means:
13	
14	(i) Any substance or mixture of substances
15	intended for preventing, destroying, repelling, or
16	mitigating any pests;
17	
18	(ii) Any substance or mixture of substances
19	intended for use as a plant regulator, defoliant, or
20	desiccant; and
21	
22	(iii) Any substance or mixture of substances
23	intended to be used as a spray adjuvant.
24	

(c) (f) "Restricted use pesticide" means any pesticide 1 2 product, the label of which states "restricted use" as required for registration by the environmental protection 3 4 agency under the federal Insecticide, Fungicide and 5 Rodenticide Act of 1972, as amended.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 9 Constitution. 10
