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6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	Section 1. W.S. 33-30-216(a) by creating a new
9	paragraph (i) and by renumbering paragraphs (i) through (v)
10	as (ii) through (vi), 33-30-219(a)(i), (b)(i) and (d) and
11	35-7-1010 are amended to read:
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13	33-30-216. Definitions.
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15	(a) As used in this act:

1 2 (i) "Animal tranquilizer" means any prescription 3 drug labeled for veterinary use by the manufacturer for the 4 purpose of immobilizing or sedating an animal to allow 5 capture or handling and which is not a controlled substance under the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act; 6 7 (i) "Board" means the Wyoming animal 8 9 euthanasia technician certification board; 10 (iii) "Certified animal euthanasia 11 12 technician" means a person who is employed or sponsored by 13 a law enforcement agency whose duties include euthanizing unwanted, sick, injured or dangerous animals; 14 15 (iii) (iv) "Euthanasia" or "euthanizing" means 16 17 the act or practice of providing a humane death for animals through the use of euthanizing drugs; 18 19 (iv) "Euthanizing drugs" means 20 any 21 pentobarbital-based drug labeled by the manufacturer for 22 the purpose of euthanizing animals, with the exception of 23 Schedule I drugs as defined in W.S. 35-7-1013 and 35-7-1014; 24

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1 2 (v) (vi) "This act" means W.S. 33-30-216 through 3 33-30-222. 4 5 33-30-219. Certified animal euthanasia technicians; eligibility; surrender or revocation of certificate; fees; 6 7 other requirements. 8 9 (a) Any person applying for a certification as an 10 animal euthanasia technician shall be employed or sponsored by a law enforcement agency. An applicant shall make a 11 12 written application to the board which shall include: 13 (i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to 14 rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars 15 (\$100.00) W.S. 33-1-201; 16 17 (b) A certification issued pursuant to this section 18 shall be for a two (2) year period unless surrendered by 19 20 the certified animal euthanasia technician or revoked or 21 suspended by the board for cause. The certified animal 22 euthanasia technician shall renew the certificate every two (2) years. Application for renewal shall be accompanied by: 23

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1 (i) A fee in the amount established pursuant to 2 rules and regulations not to exceed one hundred dollars 3 (\$100.00) W.S. 33-1-201;

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5 (d) In addition to other requirements of this act, a certified animal euthanasia technician shall register with 6 7 the Wyoming board of pharmacy to purchase, possess and administer euthanizing drugs. Certified animal euthanasia 8 9 technicians registered as provided in this section shall be 10 allowed to purchase, possess and administer animal 11 tranquilizers. Animal tranquilizers shall only be 12 administered to animals.

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14 35-7-1010. Board of pharmacy designated agency to 15 administer registration.

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17 The Wyoming state board of pharmacy in addition to any other duties imposed upon it by law is hereby designated as 18 19 agency to administer the registration of the the manufacture, distribution and dispensing of controlled 20 21 substances as hereinafter provided in this act. The board 22 shall register certified animal euthanasia technicians as provided by W.S. 33-30-219, for the limited purposes of 23 24 purchasing, possessing and administering euthanizing drugs

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1	as defined by W.S. 33-30-216(a)(iv) <u>33-30-216(a)(v)</u>, and
2	performing the duties and powers of a certified animal
3	euthanasia technician.
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5 6	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
